

ENTRY PROCEDURE FOR CITY OF HAMILTON FACILITIES



VACCINE REQUIREMENTS

City of Hamilton requires all people 18+ to be fully Vaccinated, no exceptions. (Includes Players, Coaches, Officials, Volunteers). City and PHU have the right to override the Provinces Regulations.

SPECTATORS: 12+ required to be fully Vaccinated.

PARTICIPANTS: Under 18 are not required to be Vaccinated. Currently the various Hockey Governing Bodies are still requiring Vaccination for 12+ so if they are more restrictive, then those rules must be followed. In our case we are governed by the Ontario Women's Hockey Association (OWHA).

CHECK-IN PROCEDURES

ENTRY: Entry is through the Main Entrance of each Arena. All other Doors will be locked for entry.

CHECK-IN: every person that enters a city facility will be required to go through two checkpoints, 1) validate Vaccine Certificate, 2) sign Contact Tracing Sheet

VACCINE CERTIFICATE: A City official will be present at the door to check for Vaccination Certificate and ID, such as Health Card, Driver's License, or Child's Birth Certificate. The name on the ID must match the name on the Vaccination Certificate.

The date of the 2nd vaccine shot must be 14 days prior to the current date in order to be allowed to enter the City Facilities

CONTACT TRACING: Participants will sign a contact tracing sheet once they have been checked-in by the City official. This sheet will be kept by the city. A **TEAM OFFICIAL** needs to be available at the check-in point sign-in ALL spectators after then have been checked-in by the City official. This must include the name and phone # of each individual. The Team will keep these contact tracing sheets and must keep them for 30 days after the date.

The Team must also manage their spectators counts to be within the capacity limits required by the City. (Arena limitations are listed below)

Teams are still required to do the Digital Health Check for players, parents, and guests

MASKS (Players): Worn entering and exiting and while in the dressing room before and after your ice time. Mask does not have to be worn on the ice.

MASKS (Spectators): must be worn at all times in the arena.

ENTRY AND EXIT TIMES FOR CITY ARENAS

ENTRY: will be approx. 20-25 -minutes before the start of your ice time.

We would ask that players be allowed to enter first and parent entry can start once all the players are checked in.

Parents of 11 yrs. and under players are allowed to enter the dressing room area to tie child's skates.

NO WARMUPS allowed in the Arena

EXIT: City is asking to please leave the dressing rooms within 15 minutes after end of ice time. Spectators should exit at the end of their child's ice time.

SPECTATORS allowed per Arena (IMPORTANT)

Valley Park: 80 People

For Practices: 3 people per player

For Games: Home Team 2 people per player

Visiting Team 2 people per player

Rosedale, Saltfleet, Stoney Creek Arena: 60 People

For Practices: 3 people per player

For Games: Home Team 2 people per player

Visiting Team 1 person per player

PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT YOU COMMUNICATE THESE PROCEDURES AND SPECTATOR LIMITATIONS TO THE VISITING TEAMS WELL IN ADVANCE OF YOUR GAME
